

Cancellation of games must be no less than 48 hrs before scheduled game time

Forfeit of games: Fine of \$50 plus ump fees if they show

Forfeit of playoff game: Fine of \$100 plus ump fees

Forfeit of playoff series: \$500

Umpire fees: Plate: \$55.00 Bases: \$55.00 1 umpire: \$70 No Mileage to be paid

Incident reports: must be submitted no later than 48 hours after the incident

Home teams will supply game balls for all scheduled games.

PLAYER ELIGIBILITY

Roster deadline: Sat, **June 15, 2019**

Players that play one game or more with any Senior League Team will need a release before they are eligible to play on another Senior League Team.

Players that play on another Senior League Team and not released will be suspended and deemed ineligible players.

Should they play in any other baseball league after the roster deadline they will not be eligible for league or playoff play in the WSBL.

All of the above does not apply to junior, midget or college league players.

ALL Midget or Junior players on a WSBL Roster (for provincial play eligibility) or College players, MUST have the designation by their name on the roster. MID JR CLG

Players that have played one or more games with a WSBL team in the current year, will be required to obtain a release from that team before they can play or sign with another WSBL team by the roster deadline

Senior teams may use junior or midget players but they may only be affiliated with one WSBL team

A team must have 9 players to play. A 15 minute grace period will be given. If 9 players are not ready to play then the game will be considered a forfeit.

Use of ineligible players in reg season or playoffs will result in forfeiture of games: The use of non-rostered players will result in a fine of up to \$500

Player eligibility for WSBL playoffs: must appear in a minimum five regular WSBL season games and be on the 21 player roster. 4 non rostered Qualified AP's (five games) are allowed as well and must be declared before playoffs begin.
